

**STANFORD TOWNSHIP
BOARD MINUTES
MARCH 7, 2022**

1. **Call to Order:** The Stanford Township meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Supervisor Loren Daudt.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were Supervisor's Loren Daudt and Scott Johnson, Treasurer Brenda Springer and Clerk Barb Vogtlin. Chairman Wayne Anderson and Maintenance Supervisor Kevin Springer were absent.
3. **Adopt Agenda:** Motion by Scott to adopt the March 7, 2022 Township Agenda. Loren seconded and approved the motion.
4. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Scott to approve the February 7, 2022 Township Minutes. Loren seconded and approved the motion.
5. **Treasurer's Report:** Brenda read the Treasurer's Report as follows: Balance as of February 1, 2022 \$261,490.46; Interest \$5.54; Receipts \$689.26; Disbursements \$36,827.45; ending balance as of February 28, 2022 \$225,357.81. Flagship Bank Savings Account \$18,500.76; Interest \$.43; ending balance \$18,501.19; \$150,000.00 in CD's. Motion by Scott to approve the Treasurer's Report. Loren seconded and approved the motion.
6. **Commissioner's Report:** County Commissioner Greg Anderson reported that there will be a Public Hearing on March 15, 2022 for the "Draft Ordinance" regarding the 2 dwellings on a 1 parcel. On April 7, 2022 at 7:00 pm there is a re-districting meeting. He said all the Commissioners in Isanti County will be re-elected. The re-districting for Stanford will now be Standard/Athens/Precinct 1 of the City of Isanti. He stated the County Recorder left but now on a 4-5 vote they will appoint a recorder. Still working on Broad Ban. Midco is going to be doing work in Spencer Brook and Stanford this summer.
7. **Meeting Open to Public:** Paul Chergosky, 7056 261st Avenue, stated the trucks are back again and they still don't have a CUP. The fuel tank is still there, and he said they are changing big tires from 10:00 pm till midnight. He also stated road restrictions will be on soon so hopefully something can be done.

Don Hanson brought in 2 Preliminary Plats. One for Elisha and Garrett Long, Grams Legacy on Dolphin Street. And Lindsey Langer on 277th and Hwy 47. Motion by Scott to approve both Preliminary Plats. Loren seconded and approved the motion.

Tiffany Determan, Isanti SWCD, she stated the Soil & Water District is watching Blue Lake. The Isanti SWCD recently received a grant for \$384,630 to complete an alum treatment for Blue Lake. She said the purposed of the treatment is to capture the phosphorus being recycled from with the lake and it is the last major step to keep the lake off the States Impaired Waters List.

She said the treatment will benefit the lake residents and the community. The SWCD is seeking Stanford and Spencer Brook funding assistance to cover the monitoring costs. Loren stated that being Wayne is not present tonight we will continue this to our April meeting.

Dean Krause stated on Llama Street the roads are icy and should be plowed sooner than they are. Also a lot of potholes.
