

**STANFORD TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 6, 2023**

1. **Call to Order:** The Stanford Township meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Scott Johnson.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Scott Johnson, Supervisor's Wayne Anderson and Loren Daudt, Treasurer Brenda Springer and Clerk Barb Vogtlin. Maintenance Supervisor Kevin Springer was excused.
3. **Adopt Agenda:** Motion by Wayne second Loren to adopt the November 6, 2023 Township Agenda. Scott approved the motion.
4. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Wayne second Loren to approve the October 2, 2023 Township Minutes. Scott approved the motion.
5. **Treasurer's Report:** Brenda read the Treasurer's Report as follows: Beginning Balance as of October 1, 2023 \$20,346.11; Receipts \$5,702.19; Transfer from Savings \$10,000.00; CD Maturing \$150,000.00 principle, \$10,238.07 interest, total \$160,238.07; Interest \$19.91; Disbursements \$21,399.94; ending balance October 31, 2023 \$174,906.34. Flagship Bank Savings Account \$18,663.03; interest \$7.58; Transfer Out \$10,000.00; ending balance \$8,670.61. Motion by Loren second Wayne to approve the Treasurer's Report. Scott approved the motion.
6. **Commissioner's Report:** County Commissioner Mike Warring was present and stated the County will have a review joint meeting with the City of Isanti regarding CSAH 5 Intersection project. He also said they will be discussing the next steps for the open County Administrator Position. The County Board has a meeting tomorrow November 7, 2023.
7. **Meeting Open to the Public:** Tom Anderson, Bradford, asked about the Road Ordinance. Bob Ruppe has said to get as many townships as possible to everyone is uniform. Wayne said we should have another meeting to get other Townships informed. Wayne also stated that what we approved was suggestions to the Subdivision Ordinance. Wayne will call Shane Nelson at Hawkanson Anderson to set up a meeting, possibly November 30, 2023.

Don Hanson presented a Final Plat for Haynes Ridge to the Board. Motion by Wayne second Loren to approve the Final Plat for Haynes Ridge. Scott approved the motion.

Deanna Bahr was present and asked the Board for the use of the Town Hall on December 3, 2023 for Santa Claus Day. Motion by Wayne second Loren to approve Deanna to use the Town Hall at no charge, this is a community event. Scott approved the motion.

**8. Items to be added:**

- a. Sander – 1 Ton:** Motion by Wayne second Loren to approve the installation of a sander in the 1 Ton truck for snowplowing. Scott approved the motion.
- b. Salt Training:** Motion by Loren second Wayne to approve Kevin to attend a class on Salt Training and any Board members that would like to attend. Scott approved the motion.
- c. Sick Time:** Elected Officials are not eligible, but Kevin would be because he is an employee.
- d. Jivaro Street:** Wayne stated he has talked with Bob Ruppe, and we have the road agreements. Loren will talk to the homeowners. This project will be put on hold till next spring.
- e. Election Meeting:** Motion by Wayne second Loren to approve the Clerk Barb Vogtlin to attend the Election meeting on November 14, 2023 at 3:30 at the Isanti County Government Center. Scott approved the motion.
- f. Fire District:** Loren stated they don't go out on every call so it's about ½. Their pay was \$15.00 but they raised it to \$17.00. Al got a 3.3% raise. They have 29 part-time and 2 full-time employees. Al wanted to budget \$450,000 to upgrade but the budget has already been set.

**9. Miscellaneous:** Comp Plan Meeting: Loren and Scott attended this meeting. Discussion was held regarding 2 per 40 or 4 per 40. Scott said they will have one more meeting on November 29, 2023. Motion by Wayne second Loren to approve the Board to attend this meeting.

**10. Payment of Claims:** Motion by Wayne second Loren to pay the claims. Scott approved the motion.

**11. Adjournment:** Motion by Loren second Wayne to adjourn the Township meeting at 8:14 pm. Scott approved the motion.
