

**STANFORD TOWNSHIP
BOARD MINUTES
TUESDAY JULY 6, 2021**

1. **Call to Order:** The Stanford Township meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by Chairman Wayne Anderson.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Wayne Anderson, Supervisor's Loren Daudt and Scott Johnson, Maintenance Supervisor Kevin Springer, Treasurer Brenda Springer and Clerk Barb Vogtlin.
3. **Adopt Agenda:** Motion by Loren second Scott to adopt the July 6, 2021 Township Agenda. Wayne approved the motion.
4. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Loren second Scott to approve the June 7, 2021 Township Minutes. Wayne approved the motion.
5. **Treasurer's Report:** Brenda read the Treasurer's report as follows: Balance as of June 1, 2021 \$24,119.05; Receipts \$219.00, Transfer from Savings \$40,000.00; Interest \$1.27; Disbursements \$55,735.77; ending balance as of June 30, 2021 \$8,603.55. Flagship Bank Savings Account \$58,495.85; Interest \$1.63; Transfer out \$40,000.00; ending balance \$18,497.48; \$150,000.00 in CD's. Motion Scott second Loren to approve the Treasurer's Report. Wayne approved the motion.
6. **Commissioner's Report:** None.
7. **Meeting Open to Public:** George Kramer, 6663 253rd Avenue, wanted to discuss the 2 inch blacktop on 253rd Avenue. In one area he said they should have put sand and a culvert in. Xenon Street and 253rd on the corner there is water where it washed out. Also George questioned the low maintenance road on County Road 7 across from 253rd Avenue.

Dan Justin, 26001 Jivaro Street, said the road is a dead end and Ace Solid Waste said they have to bring their garbage down to the intersection because they have to place to turn around. Dan stated the road is a washboard. He asked if the Township could put a cul-da-sac in, Wayne stated the Township could not do that because they would have to buy land to put it in. Wayne stated we can look into it and eventually that road will be paved and at that point we will look into a cul-da-sac.

Dave Moritz, 7104 253rd Avenue, stated he wants to put a water line to his back property which is on Feldspar Street. The water line would go under the road. The Board said Dave would have to get an agreement with Bob Olson who also owns property there. Also the Board said if a problem arises the Township has to right to remove it. Motion by Loren second Scott to approve the water line. Wayne approved the motion.

8. Items to be added:

- a. Truck Company on 261st Avenue NW, County Commissioner Greg Anderson was going to check into this. Loren said he was going to be calling someone regarding this issue. The Board asked the Clerk to send a letter to the County asking for a copy of their CUP.
- b. **Townhall Use:** We received an email regarding the renting the Town Hall for a family reunion in 2023. The person asking to rent the hall is from Nowthen. The Board discussed this, and they said the hall should be only rented to Stanford Township residents.
- c. **Township Officer's Meeting:** Township Officer's meeting will be held on Thursday July 29, 2021 at 7:00 pm at the Isanti County Government Center. Motion by Loren second Scott to approve anyone on the Board to attend. Wayne approved the motion.
- d. **Legal Seminar:** 12th Annual Township Legal Seminar this fall hosted by Couri & Ruppe, Attorney's. Motion by Scott second Loren to approve anyone on the Board to attend. Wayne approved the motion.

9. Miscellaneous: None.

10. Payment of Claims: Motion by Loren second Scott to pay the claims. Wayne approved the motion.

11. Adjournment: Motion by Loren second Scott to adjourn the Township meeting at 8:25 pm. Wayne approved the motion.
