

**STANFORD TOWNSHIP
BOARD MINUTES
AUGUST 2, 2021**

1. **Call to Order:** The Stanford Township meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by Chairman Wayne Anderson.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were Chairman Wayne Anderson, Supervisor's Scott Johnson and Loren Daudt, Treasurer Brenda Springer, and Clerk Barb Vogtlin. Maintenance Supervisor Kevin Springer was absent.
3. **Adopt Agenda:** Motion by Loren to adopt the August 2, 2021 Township Agenda. Wayne seconded and approved the motion.
4. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Loren to approve the July 6, 2021 Township Minutes. Wayne seconded and approved the motion.
5. **Treasurer's Report:** Brenda read the Treasurer's Report as follows: Balance as of July 1, 2021 \$8,603.55; Receipts \$274,712.61; Interest \$2.37; Disbursements \$157,884.04; ending balance as of July 31, 2021 \$125,434.49. Flagship Bank Savings Account \$18,497.48; Interest \$0.46; ending balance \$18,497.94; \$150,000.00 in CD's. Motion by Loren second Scott to approve the Treasurer's Report. Wayne approved the motion.
6. **Commissioner's Report:** County Commissioner Greg Anderson said action is happening on 261st Avenue with the Trucking Company. He stated the County is checking into it. Greg Stated that October 1st there will be a public auction for Tax Forfeit of Property. Long Lake Improvement District has submitted the paperwork for the reconstruction of the dam.
7. **Meeting Open to Public:** George Kramer asked about the low maintenance road off County Rd 7. He stated when you re-do the roads you have to replace culverts and the ditch slopes 3 to 3'. He said the Township needs to replace his driveways culvert because they didn't replace it when the road was redone and paved.

Doug Steiskal, 24547 Tulip Street NW, said there is a yield sign on Tulip and 245th but he said it should be a dead-end sign on Tulip St.

Lisa & Dennis Otten, Hwy 47 has 40-acres and they would like to split off 2 lots. Motion by Scott second Loren to approve the split. Wayne approved the motion.

Larry Anderson, LLID, stated the Long Lake Improvement District easement is drawn up fixing the dam. Motion by Loren second Scott to approve the transferring of ownership of the dam to the Long Lake Improvement District. Wayne approved the motion.

Jeff Johnson, City of Isanti Mayor was present.

8. Items to be added:

a. Long Lake Improvement District: The Board signed the Resolution and will return it back to the Township Attorney Bob Ruppe.

9. Miscellaneous: Broad Ban meeting coming up, Century Link is losing interest. Motion by Loren second Scott to ahead with the American Cares Act. Wayne approved the motion.

10. Payment of Claims: Motion by Scott second Loren to pay the Claims. Wayne approved the motion.

11. Adjournment: Motion by Loren second Scott to adjourn the Township meeting at 7:50 pm. Wayne approved the motion.
