

**STANFORD TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MINUTES  
MARCH 6, 2023**

1. **Call to Order:** The Stanford Township meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by Vice Chairman Wayne Anderson.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were Vice Chairman Wayne Anderson, Supervisor Scott Johnson, Maintenance Supervisor Kevin Springer and Clerk Barb Vogtlin.
3. **Adopt Agenda:** Motion by Scott to adopt the March 6, 2023 Township Agenda. Wayne seconded and approved the motion.
4. **Approve Minutes:** Motion by Scott to approve the February 6, and February 22, 2023 Township Minutes. Wayne seconded and approved the motion.

Rd. 5 in Isanti, remodel Family Services, approve consumption and display permit for renewals for Cambridge Curling Club.
